SAMPLE CONCENTRATIONS

These are some of the more common fields in public health. Students are free to design their own concentration with appropriate courses – these examples simply model how to combine the right courses to ensure strong preparation for a specific field of public health. As a reminder, Nursing courses are only open to Nursing majors. The inclusion of Nursing courses in these examples is intended to provide a pathway for former Nursing majors to transfer some of their coursework to the Public Health major.
